So far, we are following the general convention of two days gap between last date of submission of bids and date of opening of bids for ensuring that the original documents to be sent in physical mode (bid security, power of attorney) are received in the office of the bid inviting authority before opening of bid.

However in the instant case, this provision has been denied. Is it because the system has yet to prove the integrity? Or we also require to follow this system in case of NIC or other World Bank complaint e procurement system.
