

MEASURING **IS THE WAY**

Measurement is the first step that leads to control and eventually to improvement. If you can't measure something, you can't understand it. If you can't understand it, you can't control it. If you can't control it, you can't manage it.

This applies especially to water resources, where availability varies in both time and space and the demand keeps on rising due to rise in population, rising standards of living, increasing climate variability and change and growing environmental concerns. Given the resource constraint, governments and local agencies have to establish clearly defined policies based on the knowledge of the resource itself and the demands for food production, domestic needs, industrial activity, hydropower generation and the needs of the ecosystems. The demands from various sectors and sections of society have to be met in an equitable, just, economic and sustainable manner. This calls for

NATIONAL HYDROLOGY PROJECT (NHP)

The Ministry of Water Resources, River Development & Ganga Rejuvenation, with support from the World Bank, is undertaking National Hydrology Project (NHP) with the objective "to improve the extent, quality and accessibility of water resources information, and to strengthen the capacity of water resources management institutions in India". The project has a Pan-India coverage and envisage to support the development of hydrometric networks, data management systems, water resources information system, development of standardized methodologies and tools for water resources operations and planning procedures. The project is sub-divided into four major components: (A) Water resources monitoring systems; (B) Water resources information systems; (C) Water resources operations and planning systems; and (D) Institutional capacity enhancement.
